HISTORY AND TIMELINE

ollowing a word from God to "go establish a church that would be on a new horizon," Ronnie C. Crudup, Sr. founded New Horizon as New Horizon Baptist Church in August 1987. The first worship service was held on September 6, 1987 at New Heights Seventh Day Adventist Church.

The congregation started with 61 charter members along with their children. During the first two years of our existence, First Lady Jacqueline Crudup established New Horizon Child Care in 1988, we started Children's Church led by Charles and Gail Smith, we aired our first radio broadcast on WOAD, and we became the first non-state certified Elderly Daycare Facility in addition to establishing New Horizon Ministries, Inc. in 1989. The congregation met in a variety of rented facilities during the first three years which included New Heights Seventh Day Adventist Church, The Holiday Inn-Medical Center (now the Cabot Lodge-Millsaps), Grove Park Community Center and the Jackson Mini Mall Shopping Center. The following are significant dates and events in the 35 year history of NHCI.

- **1990 ◆** Hired first church employee in March (Susan Forrest) Purchased 2650 Belvedere Dr. location
 - ◆ (First worship service was Sept. 2, 1990)
- 1992 ◆ Formed fellowship with Trinity Presbyterian Church
 - New Horizon Drug and Alcohol Ministry was established as the first state certified African American transitional drug rehab program
 - ◆ First Holyween Celebration
- **1993** ◆ Established Faithworks (youth employment training program)
- **1994** ◆ Constructed the Family Life Center adjacent to 2650 Belvedere location
 - ◆ First full time African American Youth Pastor hired in the State of Mississippi (Henry Murphy)
- **1995** ◆ Established New Horizon Boys' Academy (Steve Cooper, Principal)
- 1996 ◆ New Horizon Bookstore was opened. Managed by Wallace and Janie Horton
- **1998** ◆ Changed our form of governance and deleted "Baptist" from our church name and was then known as New Horizon Church

- ◆ Acquired New Horizon Center on Wheatley St.
- ◆ Dr. John Parrish appointed as first Executive Pastor
- 1999 ◆ Formed international partnership with Malawi, Africa
 - ◆ Received 70 acres of land on McDowell Rd. as a gift
- 2000 ◆ Aired first television broadcast on PEG and FOX
- **2001** ♦ Inspirational Choir produced its first CD (That I May Know Him)
 - ◆ Formed MS Faith Based Coalition for Community Renewal
- 2002 ◆ NHCI Community Service Awards established in 2001, first honorees in 2002
- **2003** ♦ Joined the Fellowship of International Churches (FOIC)
 - ◆ Pastor Crudup ordained as Regional Bishop of Mid-South Dioceses
 - ◆ Ordained first female ministers (Annette Patrick and Cathy Lewis Funchess)
 - ◆ Joe Jackson appointed as Executive Pastor
- **2004** ♦ Sent missionary couple to full time ministry in Malawi, Africa (Henry and Deborah Joseph)
 - ◆ Marsha Traylor appointed to lead Youth Ministry
- **2005** ◆ Purchased Old Ellis Isle Shopping Center and renamed it "Renaissance Centre"
- **2006** ◆ Ordained 1st female Elder (Wendy Welch)
 - ◆ Change name to "New Horizon Church International"
 - ◆ Sam Wheat appointed to lead Children's Church Ministry
- 2007 ◆ Renovated and moved administrative offices to Renaissance Centre
- 2008 ◆ Started first phase renovations of our church facilities in the Renaissance Centre
- **2009** ◆ NHCI members marched on Saturday, November 14, 2009 from our Belvedere location to the Renaissance Centre.
 - ◆ Our first worship service was held on Sunday, November 15, 2009 in the Renaissance Centre
 - ◆ Jacqueline Vann appointed as Chief Financial Officer
- 2010 ◆ Formed Ekklesia School of Ministry and Theology
 - ◆ New Horizon Boys' Camp was started


- 2011 ◆ We Make it Better Foundation created
 - ♦ I-58 Project created to reclaim South Jackson
 - ◆ Vince Gordon appointed as Youth Pastor
- 2012 ◆ Renovation of Youth Ministry Room
 - ◆ Charles and Gail Smith return to lead Children Church Ministry
- 2013 ◆ Purchased of Old Sam's Building (NHMI)
- 2014 ◆ Purchase of 80 acres around the New Horizon Ministries location on Wheatley St.
- 2015 ♦ Hugh Davis returns after 20 years to be Worship Arts Ministry Pastor
- **2016** ♦ Consecration of the Mother Sadie Jones Prayer Room
 - ◆ The creation of the NHMI Development Academy
 - ◆ Dedication of space in Church to Younger, Parrish, Fair, Gibbs, Thomas and Jones
 - ♦ Henry Joseph ordained as Bishop
 - ◆ Stan Johnson elevated to Assistant Pastor
 - ◆ Start of Saturday Worship Services
- 2017 ◆ Established the New Horizon Network
 - ◆ I-58 Housing Program partnered with the MS Secretary of State Office
 - ◆ Renovation of Event Halls, Dock, Kitchen, Chapel and second Story Education and Rental Space
 - ◆ Purchase of the Brookwood Country Club (NHMI)
- 2018 ◆ Renovation of Children Church Space
 - ◆ Acquisition and Renovation of Terry Rd Swimming Pool (NHMI)
 - ◆ Saturday Worship Service changed to The Hill Experience
 - ◆ Alice Buckhanan appointed as Pastor of Missions and Outreach
 - ◆ Cassandra Moore appointed as Pastor Inreach/Equipping Ministries
 - ◆ Aurelius Williams assigned as Pastor of Ministry Operations
 - ◆ Dedication of Children's Ministry Hall to Mary Johnson
 - ◆ Dedication of Corporate Prayer Wall to Bobby and Sylvia Anderson
 - ◆ Dedication of Area in Sanctuary to Dawn Graham
- 2019 ♦ Launch of New Horizon Rankin Campus
 - ◆ Dance Rehearsal Space Renovated

2021 ◆ Restart of 11am Sunday Services
