RITES OF PASSAGE HISTORY

The New Horizon Church International Rites-of-Passage program was established in 2001 to reflect the Reaching, Teaching, and Equipping aspects of the mission statement under which the church operates. Rites of passage are those learning experiences, rituals, and ceremonies by which individuals in age specific groups successfully proceed from one clearly defined stage of development to the next stage in life. To reach young people is to openly recognize the gifts and abilities they acquire through their daily walk, talk, and activities in God's kingdom. To equip young people is to help them move effectively, efficiently, and successfully from childhood to young adulthood.

The Rites-of-Passage Program has three levels of emphasis: PREP (Preparing, Rearing and Educating our Promises): REAL (Rearing Effective Adolescent Leaders): and OTA (Orientation to Adulthood).

PREP is an academic year program for 12-year-olds. This level deals with issues that pre-teenagers face daily such as: How to study, read and understand the Bible, Christian ethics, sexuality, developing healthy relationships with family and friends, basic etiquette, decision making, and leadership principles. Guest speakers and field trips are integral parts of this experience.

REAL is an academic year program for 13-year-olds that is designed to continue challenging youth about knowing God's Word and how to use it in the difficult situations they face. Topics include: Biblical Foundational Truth, How to Establish a Personal Intimate Relationship with God, Seeking Wise Counsel, How to pray, and Spiritual Warfare. Upon completing REAL, youth are eligible to participate in the Annual Rites-of-Passage Graduation Ceremony.

OTA is open to High school seniors and is the program's highest level. This phase begins in Mid-August and concludes at the end of December. includes: God's Will Subject matter in our Lives. Career College Decision-making, Preparation, Financial Management, Relationships, and Discerning Attacks of the Enemy. Youth who complete OTA qualify to participate in the Ordination to Adulthood Graduation Ceremony.

Dr. Love-Rankin has a Bachelor of Arts degree in Elementary Education from Delta State University, a Master of Arts degree in Reading from Jackson State University, and Specialist and Doctorate degrees in Educational Leadership from Mississippi College. In her spare time, she enjoys writing and reciting inspirational poetry. She is a published author, and has recently finished writing her second book, a 30-day devotional.
